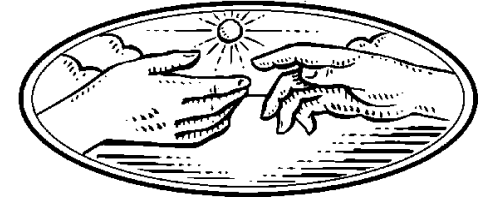

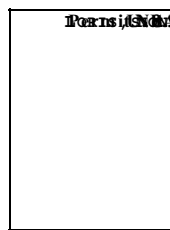
FROM OUR PASTOR

Christmas Packets for Prisoners



Why have S.C. Baptists, like many of you, been giving so faithfully to this project since 1976? The reason is to demonstrate love and hope to inmates in our state-owned penal institutions. Many men, women, and youth have no one who cares for them. Many have no visitors nor do they receive gifts at Christmas. Some inmates have received the True Christmas Gift, Christ, because of this ministry.

One male inmate wrote, "I want to thank you for the gift packs you all sent. I can now write my wife and kids through the holiday. Brushing my teeth with real toothpaste and washing with real soap is wonderful. I thank you from the bottom of my heart. You are showing a dying world that Jesus loves you no matter who you are. Please pray that I will have the courage to get back up and fight the good fight without fainting."

Bring packets with the following items to the basket outside the church office by Sunday, October 19.

- ★ *One blue or black non-retractable pen (no wire clip)*
- ★ *One 6 oz. or larger toothpaste*
- ★ *One adult toothbrush (factory sealed)*
- ★ *One 4 to 6 oz. bar of soap*

- ★ *Five first-class stamp embossed #10 envelopes (purchase at U.S. Post Office)*
