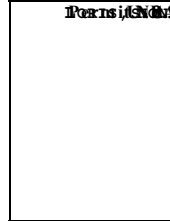

- ▶ 25,000 is South Carolina's goal for Christmas Prisoner packets.
- ▶ Prisoner Packet items are named by the South Carolina Department of Corrections.
- ▶ Volunteers check bags for these exact items and remove others.
- ▶ A Christmas message and a scripture booklet are added.
- ▶ Chaplains and volunteers deliver bags to inmates at Christmas.

Won't you help by filling a bag for S.C. inmates from the list below and bring it to the basket by the church office by this Sunday, October 19. Our church goal is 50 packets.

- ★ One blue or black non-retractable pen (no wire clip)
- ★ One 6 oz. or larger toothpaste
- ★ One adult toothbrush (factory sealed)
- ★ One 4 to 6 oz. bar of soap
- ★ One 50 to 100 page writing tablet (no wire bound)
- ★ Five first-class stamp embossed #10 envelopes (purchase at U.S. Post Office)
- ★ Two rolls of candy (LifeSavers, Mentos, BreathSavers type)
- ★ 1 gallon size zipper bag
