**"Operation Christmas Child"**

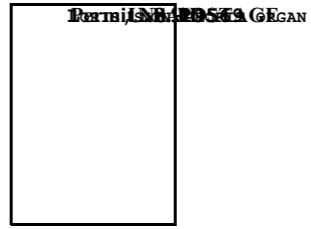
