"Living with Urgency: Share God's Transforming Power"

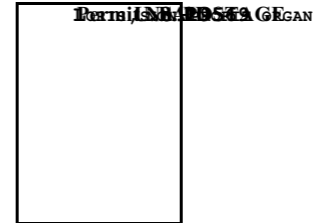
