




Do You See What I See?

"Where there is NO VISION, the people perish..." - Proverbs 29:18 (KJV)

"If people CAN'T SEE WHAT GOD IS DOING, they stumble all over themselves; But when they attend to what he reveals. THEY ARE MOST BLESSED." – Proverbs 29:18 (The Message)



In order for people to work well together over an extended period of time, it is important for them to share the same VISION (Proverbs 29:18a); otherwise, "... they stumble all over themselves" (Proverbs 29:18b). In this context, having a common "vision" does not mean people actually "see", physically, the exact same thing at the exact same time. Rather, it means they know WHAT they are doing, WHY they are doing it, and for WHOM they are doing it. A church that shares a common "vision" is a church that knows WHAT the church IS, WHAT the church IS TO DO, WHY the church IS TO DO IT, and FOR WHOM the church IS TO WORK TOGETHER to achieve common goals.

As I read the Bible, I think the "VISION" that God would unite His children at Loris FBC around could very well be: "On mission with Christ to connect people to God and His Church!" I believe this simple statement of purpose answers questions like: Why does Loris FBC exist?; What is Loris FBC to do?; Why should Loris FBC do what we do?; FOR WHOM should Loris FBC do what we do?; etc., etc.

God's Word is clear that Jesus Christ died to "establish" the church (Matthew 16:18-21), so the church is very important to Him. God's Word also reveals that Loris FBC exists to be a Spiritual Temple in which God dwells (Ephesians 2:19-22) and to be Christ's body on this earth until He physically returns, Himself (Colossians 1:13-18). Loris FBC also exists because we have been called by God to work together to be laborers in His harvest field (Matthew 8:37-38; John 15:16) to perform the task of "The Ministry of Reconciliation" (2Cor 5:18-20). Thus, I believe our common "vision" should be that Jesus Christ, as our Lord and Savior, has therefore called us to be ON MISSION WITH HIM (Luke 19:10: John 14:12: Luke 9:23) to connect people to God and His church.

Therefore, Loris FBC, as a Bible believing church, should "envision" themselves working effectively together to connect people "to God" so that He can save them (Romans 10:13), change their lives (2Cor 5:17), and empower them to live Christ-like lives (John 15:5). We also should "envision" ourselves as united in trying to connect all believers to "His church" so that they can be loved (John 13:34-35), discipled (Eph 4:11-14), protected (Ecclesiastes 4:9-12), encouraged (Heb 10:24-25), and properly utilized within the body of Christ (1Cor 12:4-11).
