

## My New "Favorite" Christmas Hymn???

One of my memories of my least favorite year at the Citadel (freshman "KNOB" year, 1979), involves the Christmas season. You see, freshmen at the Citadel, for several weeks prior to Christmas vacation, would be gathered together in formation to sing Christmas Carols for 15-30 minutes before each evening meal. Of all the songs we were forced to sing, "The Twelve Days of



Christmas" was my least favorite and became quite irritating to sing (most of us never could remember what happened on day nine through twelve!!!). Besides, I never could figure out why someone got twelve days to celebrate Christmas and get gifts...when everyone else only enjoyed one. I don't think I have sung that song one time since my Citadel days, nor did I ever want to... that is, until NOW:

A few days ago, someone in our church (who wishes to remain anonymous) gave me some information about the origination of the song "Twelve Days of Christmas" that completely changed my appreciation for this carol. Neither he, nor I, have verified the complete accuracy of this historical account...however, I think you will agree with me that it doesn't really matter, because just the thought that it "might" be true helps make this song become very special. See if you agree with me:

People often think of "The Twelve Days of Christmas" as the days proceeding the festival. Actually, Christmas is a season of the Christian year that lasts for the days beginning December 25<sup>th</sup> and lasting until January 6<sup>th</sup>, the Day of Epiphany when the Catholic church celebrates the revelation of Christ as the light of the world and recalls the journey of the Magi. From 1558 until 1829, people in England were not allowed to practice their faith openly. During this era, someone wrote "The Twelve Days of Christmas" as a kind of secret catechism that could be sung in public without the risk of religious persecution. The song has two levels of interpretation: the surface meaning...and then the hidden meaning known unfiltered to the members of the church at that time. Each element of the carol is a code work for a spiritual reality:

First of all, My "true Love" is God, the Father, who art in Heaven. The twelve things He gives us are:

- 1. The partridge in a pear tree is Christ, God, the Son.
- 2. The two turtle doves are the Old and New Testament.
- 3. Three French hens stand for Faith, Hope, and Love.
- 4. Four calling birds are the Four Gospels.
- 5. The five golden rings recall the Torah (Law)... the first five books of the Bible.
- 6. The six geese a laying stand for the six days of creation.
- 7. Seven swans a swimming represents the sevenfold ministries of God, the Holy Spirit. (Isaiah 11:2)

- 8. The eight maids a milking are the eight beatitudes. (Matt 5:3-10)
- 9. Nine ladies dancing are the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit. (Gal 5:20-22)
- 10. The ten lords a leaping are the 10 Commandments.
- 11. Eleven pipers piping stand for the eleven faithful disciples (Judas excluded!).
- 12. Twelve drummers drumming symbolize the 12 points of belief in the apostles creed:

## "Apostles Creed"

- (1) I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and earth; (i.e. God created everything that exists!)
- (2) And in Jesus Christ His only Son our Lord; (i.e. Jesus was God manifested in the flesh)
- (3) who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, (i.e. Virgin Birth)
- (4) suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; and descended into Hades. (i.e. Jesus Suffered, Died, and was Buried)
- (5) The Third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into Heaven, and sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty. (i.e. Jesus rose from the dead!)
- (6) Whence He shall come to judge the quick and the dead. (i.e. Jesus is going to return physically to earth!)
- (7) I believe in the Holy Spirit; (i.e. The Trinity: God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit)
- (8) the holy Catholic Church;
- (9) the communion of saints; (i.e. Christians are to worship and serve
- (10) the forgiveness of sins; (i.e. God forgives our sins when we place faith in Jesus Christ)
- (11) the resurrection of the body; (i.e. Our bodies will rise from the graves as glorious bodies if we have trusted Christ!)
- (12) and the life everlasting. (i.e. There is eternal life after death!)

As I admitted earlier, I have not verified the accuracy of this story...nor do I intend to in the near future. For me, even if it is not true, it doesn't really matter. Because, it has turned an irritating meaningless Christmas Carol into a memorable glorious reminder of the great gifts our true love (God) has given us through faith in Jesus Christ. So... "Merry Christmas"...enjoy your version of the 12 Days of this great holiday... AND:
