

#### It Is Time To Determine The Cost

Luke 14:28-30 "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Will he not first sit down and estimate the cost to see if he has enough money to complete it? For if he lays the foundation and is not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule him, saying, 'This fellow



began to build and was not able to finish." Luke 14:28-30

Last fall, if you remember, many of the members of our Loris FBC family filled out and turned in a Church Health Assessment Survey as a part of the CHAMPS Process in which we are currently participating. As a reminder, CHAMPS is an acronym for Church Health Assessment and Mobilization Process Strategy. In summary, it is a Southern Baptist method to evaluate the six (6) functions of a truly "biblical" church (Acts 2:42-47). These functions include Worship, Discipleship, Prayer, Fellowship, Evangelism, and Ministry. A church that does all of these consistently, and effectively, will "grow" as God is "growing His kingdom" (Acts 2:47; Matthew 13:31-34). Once a church "assesses" its "suspected" strengths and weaknesses (accomplished through the Surveys that were turned in last October), the CHAMPS Process is an organized way to get the whole church to work together as the body of Christ to determine and prioritize improvements that need to be made in order to better fulfill our Lord's Great Commission that He gave to us: "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you..." (Matthew 28:19-20)

To assist the staff in properly explaining and implementing the CHAMPS Process here at Loris FBC, we have assembled a temporary CHAMPS TEAM from amongst the various leaders and committee Chairmen in our church. Those currently on the CHAMPS Team include Dottie Ammons. Mike Blanton, Wayne Fox, Cindy Fox, Dale Holt, Neil James, Rev. Hunter Johnson, Dax Marlowe, Gene Mills, Pat Piver, Elisabeth Porter, Patty Sue Sanders, Kay Vaught, Phyllis Williams, and Dr. Louis Venable. These are the people who will work together to come up with Loris FBC's 5 and 10 year "visions" of what we believe God wants our church TO BE and TO BE DOING in the future. They will also be conducting several church-wide "workshops" and "listening sessions" to hear everyone's concerns and opinions on what needs to be changed, improved, emphasized more, or considered in order for Loris FBC to be and to do what our Lord desires for us as a church family so that we will truly be the "salt" and "light" that our local community, state, nation, and world needs for Him (Matthew 5:13-16).


