"Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken your first love. Remember the height from which you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place." (Revelation 2:4-5)

The President of the United States gave His "State of the Union" Address last Tuesday evening (January 30th). President Trump used this speech to talk about all the positive things (at least in his opinion) that have happened in our country since he was elected, as well as a list of things that still need to be worked on and improved. The purpose of a "State of the Union" Address is to give the leader of our great nation the opportunity to tell the citizens (he is supposed to be working for) what is the current "condition", "status", "strengths", "weaknesses", etc., of the things that should matter most to all Americans (i.e. our economy, our military, current wars, serious problems, future goals, etc., etc.). Our President summarized the current "state" of our Union as "much improved" over the previous years...with many problems still to solve...and many more goals to accomplish.

Regardless of whether you agreed with President Trump's assessment of America in 2018 or not, I decided while I was listening to his comments that it would be a good time for me to give my Loris FBC family a "State of The Church" assessment. So, in this Newsletter Article, I have decided to provide you with an overview of the current status of "The Church" in America as a whole, the current status of Loris FBC in particular, and my thoughts on what our church should be working on together in the future so that Jesus will remain pleased with us (Revelation 3:8).

First of all, the "state" of the American Church is NOT GOOD! According to a 2017 study by Hartford Institute for Religious Research, most American churches now have less than 100 in weekend worship attendance. This marks the first time the majority of churches have fallen below that threshold since the series of studies began in 2000. Although the population in America has increased from 2005 to 2017, 58 percent of U.S. churches didn't reach triple digits on the weekend in 2017 as compared to 49% that didn't reach triple digits in 2005. This clearly means that the American church is declining... and failing in its mission to "seek and save the lost"! Another sad statistic revealed in recent studies of Christianity in America is that over 17.000+ churches AVERAGE LESS THAN 30 IN ATTENDANCE on Sunday mornings. Yes, there are quite a few "mega" churches (averaging over 1000 each week) in our country; however, the overall average mean attendance amongst the nearly 300,000+ local Christian churches in America is around 80 in Sunday worship. This means that less than 20% (less than 1 out of 5!) of people living in America go to church on any given Sunday. In addition, the number of people attending a weekly bible study (Sunday School, Discipleship Class, Small Group, etc.) in American churches has declined by 38% since 2005.cont'd

However, because the current Loris FBC leadership (Staff, Church Council, and Deacons) are all praying and working together in unity as the Lord desires (Ephesians 4:3) to obey the "Great Commandment" and the "Great Commitment", we are one of the few churches in America that are "growing" and "making a difference" in our surrounding community. Let's rejoice and praise God for this blessing...AND...let's "remain in Christ" in 2018 so that my "State of Loris FBC" report in 2019 will be even better!! - Pastor Louis

Yes, we still have a lot to do to accomplish all of

our CHAMPS Goals. We are facing big decisions

in the near future on what are we going to do

It is not surprising then to know that church researchers are reporting that nearly 60 Christian churches close their doors in America each week (over 3000 a year!) and this trend has been happening for over 15 years. One report I recently read stated that less than 6% of all Christian churches in America reported an increase in attendance in 2017 as compared to 2016. Thus, while our country may currently be experiencing a rise in the stock market and economic prosperity, "The Church" is just continuing to decline in membership and spiritual influence. It appears we are truly in what some experts call the "Laodicean Church Age" (read Revelation 3:14-18).

Now that you have a brief "status" of the American Church as a whole, how are we doing at Loris FBC? If you have received my letter that I sent with your end of the year contribution statement, you may already have noticed that our worship attendance in 2017 was 14% higher than it was in 2016 (194 –vs- 170). Sunday School and Undesignated Budget Offerings also went up in 2017 (up 7% and 6%+ respectfully!). In addition, we baptized 15 new believers in 2017 and had over 20 new people join our church family. Some of these new members are young couples who are bringing young children to our church and new babies to our nursery. Praise God for this UNUSUAL BLESSING on an American Church!

I am not reporting these results to you as a way to boast or brag about what "I" or "we" have done; rather, I am letting you know these things so that WE WILL NOT TAKE OUR GROWING CHURCH FAMILY FOR GRANTED. As stated above, a growing church in America is unfortunately a RARE PHENOMENON. Jesus gave His disciples a clear warning when He said, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; APART FROM ME YOU CAN DO NOTHING." (John 15:5) I firmly believe that our church is currently experiencing God's blessings of growth because we have dedicated ourselves to obeying His Great Commandment ("Love One Another"; John 13:34-35) and carrying out His Great Commission ("Go and Make Disciples"; Matthew 28:19-20). By sticking to our CHAMPS Strategic Plan that we agreed to in 2016, as well as making significant sacrifices (time, finances, effort) to share the gospel in Israel, Atlanta, and Loris, our "remaining in Jesus" has allowed us the privilege of seeing His Spirit and His power advance His kingdom through us (Matthew 13:31-32). Our efforts to "disciple" adults, youth, and children to become more like Christ in how we think, speak, and act is exactly what the Bible says a healthy church is to do (2Timothy 2:20, 3:16-17) and is the main reason why most churches are failing. Dr. Tom Fillinger, CEO of IgniteUS and a Church Health Consultant with over 25 years of experience wrote: "The American Church is dying because it is failing to DISCIPLE its members so that they can experience the transformation that loyalty to Christ demands! A true Christian should be becoming more and more like Christ. It is the mission of a biblical church to help them achieve that high calling. Churches that fail to purposefully disciple their flock in a manner that brings Christ-like transformation into their lives will eventually, even if unintentionally, DIE. Show me a church that does not have teaching the knowledge and application of the Word of God to old and new members...and I will show you a church that is declining in member attendance, community influence, and spiritual power."

In conclusion, although the "State of The Church" in America is declining, I am excited to report that the "State of Loris FBC" is doing quite well. We are evangelizing the lost, discipling the found, equipping the discipled, and sending the equipped (to witness to a lost and dying world!).
