

### The Benefit of Worship, Sunday School, and Revivals

"It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be EVANGELISTS, and some to be PASTORS AND TEACHERS, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ. Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ." - Ephesians 4:11-13

Starting this Sunday, April 1st, and going through Friday, April 6th, everyone in the Loris FBC church family will have an opportunity to benefit from listening to good teachers (Sunday School), pastors (Worship Service), and evangelists (Revival Services) as they expound on and teach the Word of God. Paul makes it clear in Ephesians 4:11-15 what some of the main purposes are for why Jesus Christ gave "spiritually gifted" evangelists, pastors, and teachers to His church. These verses provide at least (4) benefits that YOU can receive IF YOU make the effort to listen and learn from those God has anointed to serve the church in these positions:

1) It will prepare you for "works of service" - Paul had already written in Ephesians 2:10 that when God "saves" a person, that born again Christian has been "made new" by Christ to accomplish "good works" that God has "foreordained" for that person to do even "before" the world began. Every believer in Christ has things that God wants that purpose to accomplish "for" Him (with His help). To "prepare" believers to do what He has "called" them to do, God provides evangelists, pastors, and teachers to "disciple" them. This includes "teaching" YOU to not only know what the Word of God "says", but how the Word of God should be "applied" to YOUR daily life. The more YOU know and can apply God's Word, the more prepared YOU WILL BE to accomplish the "works" God desires for YOU to do as His servant!

2) It will help you to be "built up" within the Body of Christ – In 1Corinthians 12:12-28, Paul uses how all of the various parts of the human body work together as an analogy of how believers are to work together within "the church" that God places them. Although we are all different (just as the eye is different from a hand, and a hand is different from a foot), we all have unique talents, abilities, and spiritual gifts that are critical to how the "body of Christ" (i.e. "the church") effectively functions TOGETHER to accomplish what the Lord ("the head of the body") wants to get done on earth before He comes for us. God's appointed evangelists, pastors, and teachers are tasked with helping all of the believers to learn what are the various "roles" that are NEEDED to be filled within a good church and help each individual believer find which "role" or "roles" contid

## **Constitution & Bylaws Committee Proposal**



the Holy Spirit wants them to fill within the church He places them. Therefore, if you take advantage of what evangelists, pastors, and teachers can teach you, YOU will discover WHY God has placed you here at Loris FBC and WHAT ROLES He intends for YOU to fill within this "body of Christ" to better help us accomplish His will and purposes on this earth!

3) It will help you reach "Spiritual Maturity" - Paul says that another goal of evangelists, pastors, and teachers within a good church is to help each individual believer reach "spiritual maturity". One of the "evidences" that a Christian is "spiritually mature" is that they not only know what God wants them to do (i.e. "their foreordained service that God has called them to") and how their "service" and "purpose" fits within the body of Christ (i.e. "the local church they attend"), BUT ALSO they know how to "distinguish" between "good" and "evil" choices as they live godly and holy lives before the Lord (see Hebrews 5:14). Not all of a believer's life is spent AT CHURCH or on doing MISSION PROJECTS for the Lord. The majority of a believer's life is "out in the world". A "spiritually mature" believer knows how to honor God at work, at home, on vacation, in the marketplace, etc., etc. Godly evangelists, pastors, and teachers can help YOU with normal human activities such as "raising your children", "handling your finances", "interacting with others in the world around you", etc., etc., in a way that brings glory and honor to the God who saved YOU (see Matthew 5:16).

4) It will protect you from being "Deceived by False Doctrine" and help you be able to "Witness to the Truth" – Paul goes on in Ephesians 4:14-15 to say that godly evangelists, pastors, and teachers have also been given to the church by Jesus Christ to keep believers from being "tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching". Paul knows that Satan does NOT want believers to accomplish the "work" God has called them to do. Satan also does NOT want a believer to properly function within the church nor reach a point of spiritual maturity in a way that would allow that believer to bring glory to God. Therefore, He "disguises" Himself and utilizes "false teachers" (see 2Corinthians 11:13-15) to try to "deceive" and "confuse" immature believers (see 2Peter 2:1-3) so that they will become "useless" in the faith and "unsuccessful" at finding and accomplishing the will of God (Romans 12:1-2). Evangelists, pastors, and teachers can not only help YOU know what is NOT TRUE, but also know what IS TRUE so that YOU can confidently "witness" and "evangelize" to a lost and dving world around YOU.

I am excited to say that, during this Easter Weekend and throughout the Revival, you are going to have the opportunity to receive all four of these spiritual benefits. That is why it is SO CRITICAL that YOU take advantage of every opportunity to attend our upcoming Sunday School, Worship, and Revival Services. I know that our daily lives are so busy, and making a living in today's economy is so difficult without working hard at our paying jobs in the world; however, if you will just "dedicate" April 1st – 6th to improving your walk with Christ...I "know" you will NOT REGRET the benefits you will receive from this sacrifice for God! - Pastor Louis
