It is hard to believe that we have already come to the end of our Spring church season. God has really blessed our Journey classes (adult & youth), as well as our AWANA and GOOD NEWS CLUB activities for children this year. In addition to our new SPORTS/VBS Camp, our summer will include a two -week tour/mission trip to Israel. From June 25th until July 9th, eleven members of Loris FBC will be going with six members of four other churches to Israel to participate in a Revival/Discipleship Conference in Bethlehem. After touring the various holy sights found in this beautiful country, we will be ministering to over 100 Arab men, women, and children who will be staying in a hotel with us for four days in Bethlehem. Church Council wanted to end the summer of 2018 by getting the whole church "family" together to have fun and take time to enjoy being together as the body of Christ at Loris FBC. This "FAMILY DAY" will include group games (such as kickball and volleyball), as well as eating and door prizes. Also, we want to use this "FAMILY DAY" as an opportunity to introduce to everyone all the new members of the church who have joined this year.

Needless to say, just because we have temporarily stopped some of our routine ministries for the summer doesn't mean we are going to be doing NOTHING throughout the next few months. Far from it! Although we all need (and deserve!) to take some time off to get renewed and refreshed before the new church year starts in September, we also need to "BE PREPARED FOR EVERY GOOD WORK" that the Lord would have us to do this summer to keep growing the kingdom of God.
