

testimonies of all the youth that came back from their weeklong trip to Camp Fuego in Texas. The theme of their youth camp was to challenge these young men and women to "remain in Jesus". All believers (not just youth) are tempted to worship Jesus "in the spirit" on Sundays and then live "in the flesh" throughout the rest of the week. But Jesus has warned us that there are consequences of not "remaining in Him" every day throughout our lives. Those who do not "remain" in Christ will not "bear fruit" (John 15:4), they will not have a powerful prayer life (John 15:7), and they will not experience "the joy of the Lord" (John 15:11). Not "remaining in the Lord" can also lead to severe discipline by God (John 15:2). So, needless to say, there are a lot of good reasons for a believer (and a church, for that matter) to "remain in Christ"!

As your pastor, I am excited to say that I am observing many signs that lead me to believe that the Loris FBC family has continued to remain in Christ...even during the summer months of this year. Typically, many churches slow down and do not accomplish much for the kingdom of God over the summer, because most members are busy with their own vacations and frequent trips to the beaches or lakes. It's almost as if they assume that there is no need to "remain in Christ" (i.e. focus on prayer, studying God's Word, and sharing the gospel with others) during the June, July, and August months...as much as we should during the rest of the months of the year. However, the Lord has told us that He could return at any moment (Matt 24:42), so we are to "keep alert" and "keep working" (Matt 24:45-46) until the Lord returns or we go to be with Him (1Tim 4:7-8).

This summer, "remaining in Christ" has led us to conduct our first ever VBS/Sports Camp at Loris High School, disciple over 100 Arab believers in Israel, take 11 children to Centri-Kid, and 25 youth to Youth Camp. This "remaining in Christ" has also led to bearing "fruit" as we have had 11 people come forward to join our church in July alone (4 of them through baptism). So, God has allowed us to continue to be fruitful over the summer because we have "remained in Him".
