

"The sorrows of those will increase who run after other gods..." (Psalm 16:4)

Last week, on the anniversary of the Roe v. Wade decision, New York State enacted a new abortion law, called the Reproductive Health Act (RHA). A longterm goal of pro-choice advocates, the law was passed by the newly elected Democratic majority in the state Senate and signed by Democratic Governor Andrew Cuomo. Upon signing the RHA bill, the governor received a standing ovation as pro-choice advocates celebrated this as a "bulwark for women's rights". The governor even ordered that One World Trade Center in New York City and several other New York state landmarks be lit in pink to celebrate the legislative victory. Now before any of you begin to think "So what? What difference does it make what a liberal state like New York does? It makes no difference in Loris. SC?", let me assure you that as "true Christians" and "obedient disciples" of the Lord Jesus Christ, IT SHOULD MATTER!!!

First of all, it should matter because ALL HUMAN LIFE (including a baby still in the mother's womb) was created "by God" and "for Him" (Colossians 1:15-16). Scripture is clear that life begins at the moment of conception (Psalm 139:13-16) and no one (not even the mother) has the "fundament right" to take the life of an unborn child (Exodus 20:13; Deuteronomy 24:16). God even demanded the death penalty for any person who purposely harmed a pregnant woman in a manner that caused her unborn baby to die in her womb (Exodus 21:22-23). Therefore, if we truly are God's children, we cannot help but believe that any "government legislation" which legalizes killing unborn (and in some cases, "recently born") babies, is NOT a God given right. Instead, it is wicked and evil in God's eyes.

Secondly, it should matter because God has given us NO EXCUSES to accept the "false claims" of the ungodly proponents of abortion rights (Romans 1:18-20). Not only has He proclaimed in Scripture that an unborn child is "His creation" and is "a life". He has also given mankind the wisdom to discover that a baby in womb has a detectable heart-beat within 18 days after conception; and after just 40 days after conception (5 and ½ weeks), the baby has detectable brain-waves, squints, swallows, can make a fist, and can kick. It is also sensitive to heat, touch, light, and noise. All body systems are beginning to work and the baby has a skeletal structure, nerves, blood circulation, evelids, fingernails, and fingerprints. All this even though it weighs only about 1 ounce, is 2.5 to 3 inches long, and can stand on your fingertip. God has also allowed man to discover, that a baby 5 and \(\frac{1}{2} \) weeks old can definitely feel and experience PAIN...including the pain inflicted during abortions in which sharp instruments are used to cut the baby into tiny parts to remove from the womb. Knowing this, why would any Christian be "okay" with the majority of abortions that even happen within the first 12 weeks of unwanted pregnancies? To sit back and do nothing while many innocent and helpless "humans" are being legally slaughtered in our country is unacceptable to our Lord and will be judged accordingly (Prov 24:10-12, Prov 31:8-9).

Thirdly, it should matter because what happens in New York does not stay in New York! Do not think that that those who pushed to have RHA approved in New York will not continue to try to have these radical pro-abortion laws presented in every state legislature in our country as soon as possible. No king is saved by the size of his army: no warrior escapes by his great strength. A horse is a vain hope for deliverance; despite all its great strength it cannot save" (Psalm 33:13-17)... "Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die. for I have not found your deeds complete in the sight of my God. Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; obey it, and repent. But if you do not wake up. I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you." (Revelation 3:2-3) When followers of Jesus Christ are confronted with evil in their society, they are not to ignore it or be afraid of it, rather we are to pray (2Chron 7:14), submit and draw near to God (James 4:7-8), and wisely fight against those things which are wrong in God's eyes (2Corinthians 10:3-5). Otherwise, we invite judgment on our nation (Zeph 3:1-6).

Therefore, as your pastor, I am asking all of my church family of Loris FBC to STAND BEFORE GOD on behalf of the unborn and be urgently praying for our nation's (as well as for our state's) leaders to be controlled by God's wisdom and not by Satan's deceptions (1Timothy 2:1-4; Acts 26:17-18). I am also asking you to be very diligent in making sure you STAND BEFORE GOD and use your right to vote to ensure that, to the best of your ability, no one is elected to office that would approve or allow wicked bills like RHA to be approved on either the state or federal level. If we don't courageously stand before God and intercede on behalf of the United States of America. I am afraid we will see our country face extreme sorrows in the near future (Psalm16:4) and find ourselves without an excuse as God says to us what He said to His people in Israel when they tolerated evil within their nation:

"I looked for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand before **me** in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found none. So I will pour out my wrath on them and consume them with my fiery anger, bringing down on their own heads all they have done, declares the Sovereign LORD." (Ezekiel 22:30-31)

So, let's obey the Word of God (Luke 11:28) and resist evil (James 4:7), as we fight to protect the lives of the "least of these" (i.e. "unborn babies") who cannot protect themselves (Matthew 25:40, 45). - Pastor Louis
