Let’s Make Calls to Save the Babies

A Personhood Bill (which prohibits abortions in South Carolina if the babies heartbeat can be detected) has been passed by SC State Representatives in the House. However, our State Senators, for the past 3 years, has refused to bring it up for a vote. In order for this Personhood Bill to be passed during this year’s sessions in the Senate, it must be set for special order for floor debate and the filibuster that will surely come against the bill has to be stopped. For the filibuster to be stopped, 3/5 of the members present must vote for the cloture which means to end all debate on the bill and take an up or down vote on the bill. 26 votes are required for this cloture and we currently have 24 of those votes. The two Republicans who have continued TO HOLD UP THIS BILL by refusing to vote for cloture are:
Republican Senator Luke Rankin: 803-212-6610 or 843-248-2405 (Dorchester District)
Republican Senator Sandy Senn: 803-212-6116 (Horry District)

Please pray that the Lord will change their hearts and then call their offices (continually if necessary) to let them know that the will of the people they represent in South Carolina, is to protect babies from being murdered when their detected heartbeats prove that they are alive in their mother’s womb.
