Stage One: The Ephesus Period (A.D. 30-100) - Rev 2:1-7

Motto – “You have fallen”
(Rom 10:17-18, 16:25-26; Col 1:6, 23)

Under Jewish (apostolic leadership) - evangelism and church starts were primary
Under Gentiles - evangelism and church planting give way to material gain & politics

Stage Two: The Smyrna Period (A.D. 100-312)-Rev 2:8-11

Motto – “You Will Suffer Persecution...”

“The period of intense church persecution!”...Satan tried to wipe church off earth!
- Tribulation for 10 days...could very well speak of the 10 emperors
