Called Business Meeting TODAY at 6 PM
to vote on the following proposal by the Transportation
Committee:

The Transportation Committee makes a motion that the church votes to sell the 2001 Chevrolet 25-Passenger Bus and the funds from the sale be used to assist in purchasing a new or used "Certified Release Time" 14-Passenger Bus, at a cost not to exceed \$65,000, that can be used for both church ministry needs and our Coastal Schools Ministry Outreach. The funds for the new bus will come from the current Loris FBC checking account.

NOTE: Because the purchase of this asset will exceed \$25,000, the vote on this motion will be conducted through paper ballots of those who attend this called business meeting on September 19th.

Getting the Gospel into Middle School!

We will be working through "Coastal Schools Ministries" to begin this ministry in Loris. Please begin praying and helping us raise the necessary \$45,000. These funds will pay for "2" teachers (\$16K a year salaries), the necessary insurance coverage, taxes, administrative needs, etc. To make a financial donation, you can write a check to Loris FBC designated "Coastal School Ministries"; through the Church App; or on our website. Just make sure to designate it specifically for "Coastal School Ministries". We need to raise the \$45K by September 30th to be assured that we can begin Bible Classes in January of 2022.
