On November 7th, 2021, we will be celebrating our 140th Birthday as a Loris FBC family. Since 1881, Loris FBC has been faithful in teaching and sharing the gospel of Christ; not only in this community, but also throughout the world. Rev. Dan Vincent (1970-1973) will be returning to be our guest preacher to deliver this year's message. We will also celebrate by eating a "family style" meal together after the worship service under a tent by the Fellowship Hall. Door prizes and other fun activities will be included in our Heritage Day fellowship. In addition, we will be attempting to meet our goal of surpassing \$100,000 after this year's Heritage Day special offering, so that we can complete our Fellowship Hall renovation and improvements. So, until then, please be in prayer that you can be prepared to give and participate in this unique opportunity to praise God for preserving and blessing our church. Thanks to Him, we are surviving through this terrible pandemic and still going strong, even after 140 years!

Getting the Gospel into Middle School!
