"IF" II Timothy 2:8-15

8 Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel, 9 for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained. 10 Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. 11 Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; 12 if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us; 13 if we are faithless, he remains faithful, for he cannot disown himself.

Dealing With False Teachers

14 Keep reminding God's people of these things. Warn them before God against quarreling about words; it is of no value, and only ruins those who listen. 15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.

Wednesday Kids' Summer Play Hangout

The Children's Council and Nursery Committee are proposing a bi-weekly "hangout" for our children throughout the summer. This "hangout" would not have a teaching aspect, but instead be a time for our kids to come to the church and play during the Wednesday Prayer and Bible Study. We would provide a snack and let them have fun playing. We would not provide nursery during this time, but instead focus on our older children. In order for this to work we will need 4 adult volunteers per week (1 security and 3 attending directly to the kids) willing to volunteer from 6 PM to 7 PM on Wednesdays. This would give our parents a chance to attend Prayer and Bible Study. We will start off with a bi-weekly plan, unless we have enough volunteers to schedule it weekly.
