Discipleship Groups

What is a disciple: a student; a learner; a follower? As Christians we are students of Jesus Christ our Savior and Lord. Do you desire to learn more about His ways and His teachings, and walk them out in your daily life? Join (or lead) a Discipleship Group at Loris FBC to study God's Word and encourage each other. Groups will begin meeting in the fall. *If you are interested, complete the Discipleship Group Information form and return it to the office.*

Fall Discipleship Class

This course provides instruction and practice in the HEAR method of Bible Study to enhance personal growth in one's faith. Arrive ready to enter an excited mode of spiritual growth. No lesson preparation is required! All work is done in class and shared in small groups. Focus is on praying, reading, meditating, and applying God's Word. The class will meet one hour each Sunday afternoon here at the church for six weeks beginning September 18, 2022. Rev. Roland Johnson will lead this group study. "UNTIL..."

Joshua 3:14 - 4:1-10

14 So when the people broke camp to cross the Jordan, the priests carrying the ark of the covenant went ahead of them. 1 When the whole nation had finished crossing the Jordan, the Lord said to Joshua, 2 "Choose twelve men from among the people, one from each tribe, 3 and tell them to take up twelve stones from the middle of the Jordan, from right where the priests are standing, and carry them over with you and put them down at the place where you stay tonight." 4 So Joshua called together the twelve men he had appointed from the Israelites, one from each tribe, 5 and said to them, "Go over before the ark of the Lord your God into the middle of the Jordan. Each of you is to take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites, 6 to serve as a sign among you. In the future, when your children ask you, 'What do these stones mean?' 7 tell them that the flow of the Jordan was cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it crossed the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever." 8 So the Israelites did as Joshua commanded them. They took twelve stones from the middle of the Jordan, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites, as the Lord had told Joshua; and they carried them over with them to their camp, where they put them down. 9 Joshua set up the twelve stones that had been in the middle of the Jordan at the spot where the priests who carried the ark of the covenant had stood. And they are there to this day. 10 Now the priests who carried the ark remained standing in the middle of the Jordan until everything the Lord had commanded Joshua was done by the people, just as Moses had directed Joshua. The people hurried over.
