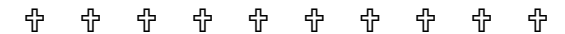

Senior Pastor Candidate

The Pastor Search Committee has recommended a candidate for the Senior Pastor of LFBC and the Deacon Board has unanimously voted to support the committee's recommendation. Dr. Kevin Phillips will be presenting a trial sermon on November 12 during our worship service.

Dr. Phillips is originally from Cowpens, SC. He is married to his wife of 34 years, Myra. They have five children from ages 23 to 33. Dr. Phillips earned his Doctor of Ministry from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary and his Master of Arts in Theological Studies from Columbia Biblical Seminary. He adheres to the Baptist Faith and Message 2000. Dr. Phillips has over 30 years of pastoral experience, including two years as an Active-Duty Army Chaplain at Fort Jackson and one year as a Staff Chaplain at a Federal Prison. He is firmly committed to the supremacy and the inerrancy of the Bible. Dr. Phillips describes himself as being theologically conservative, teaching and preaching the Bible, and a pastor who can relate to individuals on their specific level regardless of their age or stage in life. He believes that his role as a pastor begins with a committed and dedicated life that glorifies Jesus Christ and that God has called him to serve the local church as a pastor. Dr. Phillips enjoys time with his family, bicycling, kayaking, working to rebuild cars, traveling, and eating at good restaurants.
