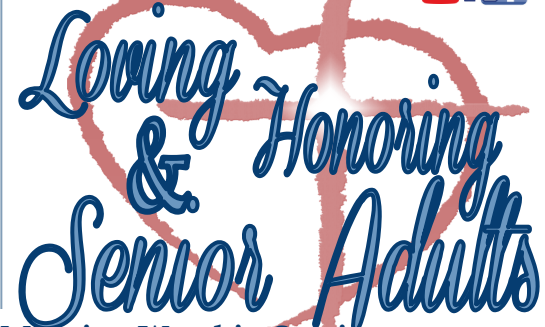

(John 15:1-8)

I Am the True Vine

15 "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. 2 Every branch in me that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. 3 Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you. 4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. 5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. 7 If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.

Motion to Call a Senior Pastor

The Pastor Search Committee has recommended Pastor Shane Phillips for consideration by the church congregation for the position of Senior Pastor of LFBC. As required by the church By-Laws, our Church Deacons met with Pastor Phillips Friday night and voted unanimously to support the committee's recommendation.

Pastor Phillips was originally from West Columbia, SC but presently resides in Bristol, TN. He is married to Misty Phillips and has two children Autumn (22) and Nicholas (16).

Pastor Phillips is a graduate of Emmanuel College with a BS degree in Christian Ministries. He also graduated from Liberty University Baptist Seminary with a MA in Religion-Biblical Studies, MA in Religious Education, and a Master of Divinity.

Pastor Phillips has served in ministerial roles over the past 28 years in churches in the Columbia area; Brunswick, GA; and most recently in Bristol, TN. Pastor Phillips is also a retired law enforcement officer with the West Columbia Police Department where he also served as the Patrol Division Commander, and Departmental Chaplain.

We have invited Pastor Phillips to visit our church on Saturday, May 11 to meet with our church Personnel Committee, Church Staff, Finance Committee, Treasurer, and Assistant Treasurer in the afternoon beginning at 12:00 PM in the church sanctuary. (A meeting invitation will be sent out to these committee members this week.) These meetings will be followed with a church-wide Meet and Greet Program to be held in the fellowship hall beginning at 3:30 PM. Those members in attendance will have an opportunity to hear Pastor Phillips speak, a chance to ask specific questions, and a chance to introduce themselves.

On Sunday May 12, Pastor Phillips will be presenting a sermon during our worship service. Immediately following the service, we will excuse Pastor Phillips and his family in order that we can conduct a Called Business Meeting. The sole purpose of the meeting will be to consider a motion from the Pastor Search Committee to call Pastor Shane Phillips as the Senior Pastor for Loris FBC with a ballot vote being taken.
