No More Time To Waste, The Hour Is At Hand! Luke 12:33-51

33 Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys. 34 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. The Faithful Servant and the Evil Servant 35 "Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning; 36 ad you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately. 37 Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them. 38 And if he should come in the second watch, or come

For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.
