You Feed Them – Laborers Needed

Luke 10:1-2

*1 After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also,
and sent them two by two before His face into every city and
place where He Himself was about to go. 2 Then He said to
them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few;
therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers
into His harvest.*

Mark 6:34-38

*34 And Jesus, when He came out, saw a great multitude and
was moved with compassion for them, because they were
like sheep not having a shepherd. So He began to teach them
many things. 35 When the day was now far spent, His
disciples came to Him and said, "This is a deserted place, and
already the hour is late. 36 Send them away, that they may
go into the surrounding country and villages and buy
themselves bread; for they have nothing to eat." 37 But He
answered and said to them, "You give them something to
eat." And they said to Him, "Shall we go and buy two hundred
denarii worth of bread and give them something to eat?"
38 But He said to them, "How many loaves do you have? Go
and see."*

John 6:8-14

*8 One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to
Him, 9 "There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two
small fish, but what are they among so many?"
10 Then Jesus said, "Make the people sit down." Now there
was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number
about five thousand. 11 And Jesus took the loaves, and when
He had given thanks He distributed them to the disciples, and
the disciples to those sitting down; and likewise of the fish, as
much as they wanted. 12 So when they were filled, He said to
His disciples, "Gather up the fragments that remain, so that
nothing is lost." 13 Therefore they gathered them up, and
filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley
loaves which were left over by those who had eaten. 14 Then
those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said,
"This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."*
